Wildlife photographer Paul Bannick appears at Everett Public Library

EVERETT, WA—Paul Bannick, award-winning author and photographer of "Owl: A Year in the Life of North American Owls" and "The Owl and the Woodpecker," will offer a free presentation on Sunday, Oct. 27, at 2 p.m. in the Everett Public Library auditorium at 2702 Hoyt Ave. in Everett.

Bannick's work can be found in many bird guides, including Audubon, Peterson, and the National Wildlife Federation. It has been featured in the New York Times, Sunset, and many other publications. His photographs are part of traveling exhibits and are included in a special exhibit in the Chi Mei Museum in Taiwan.

Bannick currently serves as director of major gifts for Conservation Northwest, an organization dedicated to protecting wild areas and recovering native species from the Pacific Coast to the Canadian Rockies.
