"American Creed" film screening and community conversation at Everett Public Library

EVERETT, WA – Everett Public Library and WSU Everett will co-sponsor a public screening of the PBS documentary "American Creed" followed by a community conversation. The program will take place at 6 p.m. on Thursday, March 5, in the Everett Public Library auditorium, 2702 Hoyt Ave., in Everett.

["American Creed"](#) shares the stories of unlikely activists who bring their communities together and confront the nation's deepest divides. Condoleezza Rice and David M. Kennedy come together from different perspectives to shed light on these stories, and what it means to be an American in turbulent times.

Following the film screening, Dr. Robert Richardson, Clinical Assistant Professor in the Edward R. Murrow College of Communication at WSU Everett, will facilitate a community conversation based on the themes raised in the film.
